**6. Presentation on Bicycle and Pedestrian Projects Submitted for STP-MM Funding (Alex Carroll / AAMPO)**

**Issue**

One of the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization's main responsibilities is to develop and maintain a Transportation Improvement Program (also known as a TIP, or short-range plan) for federally funded transportation projects and programs in the region. The TIP covers a time period of four years and must be updated every two years. This is a financially constrained plan, which means funding has been identified for the projects in the plan.

In 2017, the MPO issued a call for new projects to be included in the TIP. Approximately \$150 million in Surface Transportation Program – Metropolitan Mobility (STP-MM) funds, or "MPO funds", are available for this project call. Forty-eight transportation projects were submitted totaling about \$463 million. Of these 48 projects, eight were strictly bicycle & pedestrian projects, totaling about \$38 million. There were also bicycle and pedestrian components included in added capacity and operational projects, which total about \$19 million.

Alex Carroll will present on the bicycle and pedestrian projects, technical scoring, and TIP outreach process.
