5. Presentation on Harry Wurzbach/Austin Highway Intersection Design

Issue

The City of San Antonio is planning a reconstruction of the Harry Wurzbach/Austin Highway intersection. The project is planned to be a Single-Point Urban Interchange and is at 30% design. The project is also in the MPO's Metropolitan Transportation Plan and Transportation Improvement Program. David Lopez with the City of San Antonio Transportation & Capital Improvements Department will present the design schematic and other proposed improvements and invites PMAC to provide feedback.

6. Presentation on the Texas Strategic Highway Safety Plan

Issue

The Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) is a major component and requirement of the Highway Safety Improvement Program. SHSP's were first required under the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Transportation Equity Act – A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU), and continued under the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act). States are required to develop, implement, evaluate, and update an SHSP that identifies and analyzes roadway safety challenges and opportunities on all public roads. The SHSP is intended to serve as an umbrella document for safety plans in the state.

The Texas Department of Transportation is currently updating its Strategic Highway Safety Plan. As part of that process, stakeholders gathered to review safety data and identify safety priorities, or "Emphasis Areas". There are seven Emphasis Areas, one of which is Pedestrian Safety. Alex Carroll will present on the Pedestrian Safety team's work thus far and share opportunities for further involvement.
