4. Presentation on the City of San Antonio's Complete Streets Update

Jana Wentzel, Senior Transportation Planner with the City of San Antonio's Transportation Department will present a briefing on the City of San Antonio's efforts to update the 2011 Complete Streets Ordinance as part of a new Micromobility Policy. City staff have conducted best practice research, policy analysis, and public engagement to determine what further support is needed to implement micromobility infrastructure.

San Antonio Bike Share has grown to 65 docking stations across the city and 650 bicycles, including 189 e-bikes.
