 - a. The FY 2022 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant awards were announced. Congratulations to Bexar County, City of San Antonio, and the City of Seguin. Bexar County was awarded \$300,000 for the Bexar County Safety Action Plan, the City of San Antonio was awarded \$4,400,000 for Zarzamora Street Mid-Block Crossings and High-Injury Network Safety Campaigns, and the City of Seguin was awarded \$265,200 for the City of Seguin SS4A Action Plan.
