

AAMPO Plans and Documents





Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP): MPO staff budget and regional planning studies over a two-year timeframe; FY 2022-2023 UPWP approved in June 2021.



Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Funded transportation projects for next four years; updated every two years; Fiscal Year 2023-2026 TIP locally – approved June 27, 2022.



Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

Transportation goals, strategies, and future projects for 20+ years; *updated every four years;* Mobility 2050 locally-approved June 27, 2022.



Transportation Conformity Determination (TCD)

Evaluates future transportation projects to ensure no further harm to air quality; locally-approved (with test #1) June 27, 2022 – update scheduled for TPB Action December 12, 2022.

Amendment Process

In accordance with AAMPO policy, amendments to the Long Range Transportation Plan (MTP) and the Short Range Transportation Plan (TIP) normally occur in a two-step process with presentation one month and action the following month



One-Step Amendment Process

- Policy 3 allows information and approval in same month with 75% vote of TPB quorum
- One-step process intended to accommodate <u>state</u>, <u>federal</u>, <u>and local</u> **deadlines**
- Action must be emphasized in TPB meeting agenda 10 days prior to approval; special public hearing held within TPB meeting



One-Step Amendments

- Approval of FY 23-26 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) was delayed.
- Numerous amendments will be sought through the onestep process in January in time for the February 2023 STIP revision
 - TxDOT has several priority projects they are seeking to strategically advance in early 2023
 - Cost Increase Work Group will recommend to <u>TPB</u>
 <u>Executive Committee</u> that submitted requests for **FY23- 24 projects** be funded via <u>February STIP revision</u>
