



## **A Resolution Adopting the Safety Targets Established by the Texas Department of Transportation for Year 2025**

**WHEREAS**, the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) is responsible for a multi-modal transportation planning and programming process; and

**WHEREAS**, AAMPO provides local direction for urban transportation planning and the allocation of federal transportation funds to entities within the region; and

**WHEREAS**, Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act, Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act and Bipartisan Infrastructure Law require the implementation of Performance Measures to assist in the transportation planning process; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has adopted its Strategic Highway Safety Plan, a data-driven, statewide-coordinated safety plan to help reduce fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads; and

**WHEREAS**, TxDOT has established targets for five Safety performance measures for calendar year 2025 as follows:

1. Number of Fatalities: 2,933
2. Rate of Fatalities per 100 million Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT): 1.09
3. Number of Serious Injuries: 18,370
4. Rate of Serious Injuries per 100 million VMT: 6.39
5. Number of Non-Motorized Fatalities and Serious Injuries: 2,378; and

**WHEREAS**, AAMPO previously took action supporting TxDOT's statewide safety targets for years 2018 through 2024.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** AAMPO hereby supports TxDOT's statewide safety targets for calendar year 2025.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, AAMPO supports TxDOT's visionary goals to end traffic fatalities on Texas roads by year 2050 and reduce fatalities by half by year 2035.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, AAMPO will plan and program projects that contribute to the accomplishments of said targets and goals.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, AAMPO will monitor the established targets and goals and report achievements to the Transportation Policy Board in January 2025.
