Subject: Transportation Conformity Review and Concurrence

Dear Edward Ofori:

Thank you for the opportunity to review the 2024 Transportation Conformity report and associated documents submitted by the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) for Mobility 2050 and the 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Alamo Area. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality is satisfied that all requirements have been met and transportation conformity has been demonstrated.

The purpose of this conformity analysis was to determine if AAMPO's 2050 metropolitan transportation plan (MTP) and the 2025-2028 TIP are consistent with area emissions requirements for the Bexar County Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) Nonattainment Area. Bexar County is a serious ozone NAAQS nonattainment area without previously approved motor vehicle emissions budgets; therefore, the area is subject to interim conformity test requirements per 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §93.119. AAMPO performed both build vs. no-build and less-than-baseline tests under 40 CFR §93.119(b)(1) for the analysis years 2025, 2035, 2045, and 2050. AAMPO successfully demonstrated conformity for each analysis year.
